Scholarship Application Guidelines

In Order to apply for a Windy Ryon Scholarship you must:

- 1. Volunteer at the Windy Ryon Memorial Roping
- 2. Be a Member in Good Standing with NTHSRA
- 3. Be a graduation senior
- 4. Have competed in at least 12 rodeos your senior year by the scholarship application deadline
- 5. Have taken your SAT and or ACT (Except those that are exempt for educational programs)
- 6. Have applied to a college, university, or trade school

To apply for the Winy Ryon Scholarship you must submit:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Two letters of recommendation (EX: Business owners, city officials, school faculty, on letterhead)
- 3. Completed high school transcript-SAT/ACT scores

If you are awarded a scholarship and accept you MUST:

- 1. Give at least 30days' notice before receiving any funds
- 2. Attend the fall semester or submit a letter before January 31, 2024 with your intent or forfeit scholarship.
- 3. Use the scholarship within 6 months of August 1, 2023

This application and ALL required information should be returned in a sealed envelope, to the NTHSRA office by April 16, 2023, no later than 5pm. You will be notified if you are to be called back for an interview.
