Scholarship Application Guidelines

In Order to apply for a Windy Ryon Scholarship you must:

1. Volunteer at the Windy Ryon Memorial Roping
2. Be a Member in Good Standing with NTHSRA
3. Be a graduation senior
4. Have competed in at least 12 rodeos your senior year by the scholarship application deadline
5. Have taken your SAT and or ACT (Except those that are exempt for educational programs)
6. Have applied to a college, university, or trade school

To apply for the Winy Ryon Scholarship you must submit:

1. Completed application
2. Two letters of recommendation (EX: Business owners, city officials, school faculty, on letterhead)
3. Completed high school transcript- SAT/ACT scores

If you are awarded a scholarship and accept you MUST:

1. Give at least 30days' notice before receiving any funds
2. Attend the fall semester or submit a letter before January 31, 2024 with your intent or forfeit scholarship.
3. Use the scholarship within 6 months of August 1, 2024.

This application and ALL required information should be returned in a sealed envelope, to the NTHSRA office by April 14, 2024, no later than 5pm. You will be notified if you are to be called back for an interview.
